## Interrogative Sentence

An **Interrogative Sentence**  
is a **Question**.  
It asks for information and ends  
with a question mark.

Can dragons speak?  
How many dragon species are there?  
What is your favorite book about dragons?

## Imperative Sentence

An **Imperative Sentence**  
is a **Command**.  
It commands or requests and ends  
in a period or an exclamation point.
